KAPOSIA DAYS- 50 YEARS on 5th

South St. Paul Kaposia Days celebrates its 50th Anniversary this year. As a part of this year's celebration the Kaposia Days committee voted to move the parade from going down 7th Avenue to 5th Avenue. After having the parade go down 7th Avenue, part of the decision was to move it to celebrate 50th on 5th!

Following much discussion, except for adding two additional blocks on Southview, the route will otherwise be the same route that it has followed the past years. The parade starts at the intersection of 12th Ave. N. and 3rd Street N. and will travel south on 12th Avenue North, then east on Southview Boulevard, and then south on 5th Avenue South. The final block of the parade between 7th and 8th Streets will be a designated 'Quiet Zone' without sirens, music or other loud noises.

It is the intention of the Kaposia Days Board of Directors to provide a fun and safe parade for the community. Community members are asked to continue to be mindful of Parade Marshalls and volunteers and are asked to keep their children behind the white line in the street to ensure kids are not running into the street especially when trucks, animals are on the street. Everyone's safety comes first on parade day.

The parade will be broadcast LIVE on Town Square Television (Channel 14) and replayed on local Comcast Xfinity channel 14/HD 799 for at least a couple weeks in July.
